Chiron & Prometheus

Someone asked me if I could map the Law of Attraction to stories from mythology. So, I took a look at one of my favourite stories – the mythology of Chiron and Prometheus.

My interest stemmed from a 2 year psychological astrology course that I completed many years ago; it's where I discovered my passion to learn more about human behaviour and how conditioning impacts on all we do. One of the minor planetoids discovered towards the end of the last century was named "Chiron". In astrological circles he was known as the wounded healer, and where he appeared in the natal chart is the area where we can do things for others, but not for ourselves – a blind spot, if you like. I never fully understood this connotation, until I was asked how the law of attraction could be applied to such a story. I'll explain later on in this article.

A lot of astrology, and its accompanying psychology of human behaviour, has links to mythological stories. So I began reading them as part of my background knowledge to aid my understanding.

Who was Prometheus, you may ask. In the times long ago when mankind projected their dreams, fears and desires onto "gods", Zeus was king of the Gods, having overthrown the tyrant Chronos (Saturn), who had, in turn, overthrown the prior tyrant, Ouranos. Mythology has it that Prometheus was more loving of mankind than Zeus ever was and wanted to reward them by showing them the gift of fire. Zeus absolutely forbade it, but Prometheus did it anyway.

Zeus, angered by this, ordered that the immortal Prometheus be chained to a rock and to have his liver torn out and eaten, each day, by a giant griffon. Being immortal, his liver regenerated every day. There was only one way that Prometheus could be released from this torment – he would be released if someone would volunteer to take his place on the rock. Of course, there were no takers.

Many times the other gods, distressed at seeing their compatriot tortured each day, urged Prometheus to relent, apologise and to ask Zeus to forgive him. To which he replied "It is easy for those outside the prison wall of pain to exhort the one who suffers." He was either too attached to his pride or to his pain to let it go and ask forgiveness.

Let's go to Chiron, for a moment. Some say that Zeus came upon his mother in the form of a horse and the offspring was the first centaur, Chiron. His mother, seeing her child to be half human and half horse, begged that the gods take "this monstrosity" away. This was Chiron's first "wound" – he was abandoned by his mother at birth. Apollo raised Chiron, taught him all the gifts of martial arts and healing, and, in turn, Chiron

then became the foster parent to the children of other gods and heroes. It was Chiron who taught Heracles how to use the bow and gave the gift of healing to Jason of the Argonaut fame.

Being of godly descent, he was half divine and half animal. He was half immortal and half mortal. By now, Heracles had battled the deadly hydra and took its poison to coat all his arrows. One day, out hunting, a stray arrow accidentally hit Chiron in the thigh. The wound was in his mortal body – he was immortal and could not die, but, also, he could not heal this immensely painful wound.

The pain for Chiron was unbearable. It became so bad that he decided he had but one option. He volunteered to give up his immortality and take the place of Prometheus on the rock. The Griffon came and tore out his liver, and so died Chiron, the wounded healer.

Touched by such nobleness, Zeus commanded that Chiron be placed in the heavens as the constellation of Sagittarius – that all who gazed up would see the archer and remember him. Thus Chiron regained his immortality.

There are two big links to the law of attraction here – have you seen them yet? I'll go over the first one. The law of attraction says that like attracts like. We can have all we wish for, but, it must be wished for by a subconscious free of limitation. If we have doubts, it does not matter how much we may consciously want something, the subconscious, and so the universe, does not believe us. If we do not believe in what we want, what chance do we have of getting it? So, you get more of what you “wish for” – you get the disappointment you expected.

What are these subconscious limitations? They are belief systems conditioned into us, from childhood. They are the results of past experiences. In effect, all we believe is what we have experienced in the past. We become all we have thought. How do we get rid of those limitations? We dispel the belief patterns – we undo the conditioning.

If you remember, I said that in astrology, Chiron is thought of as the blind spot in the natal chart. Chiron believed that he could not heal the wound in his thigh. He had been conditioned to believe this. However, if you look around, you will see miracles of healing all over the world!! Chiron had a belief system that he did not recognise. Had he done so, he could have called on the universe to heal himself. The law of attraction indeed worked for Chiron. He received the pain exactly according to his belief.

Let's go to Prometheus. “It is easy for those outside the prison wall of pain to exhort the one who suffers.” Maybe Prometheus believed that he would be released. What if he believed that the universe would find a way to release him? He did not need to know the “how” or “who”, in this instance. All he had to do was “believe”. So, of course, with such a strong belief, in spite of the pain, he held firm to this belief.

The universe waited until the correct manifestation could appear. Chiron held onto a belief that he could not be healed and so suffered horrendous pain, 24 hours a day. It is not difficult to then put the two together... Prometheus had a belief, Chiron had a belief – the Universe said “your wish is my command” to both of them! The law of attraction brought them together.

Yes, this is only mythology, but, it does show how the law of attraction works. If mythology is the outer projection of human behaviour, hopes, dreams, desires and fears, then it stands to reason that the same law of attraction will work for these mythological stories.

Prometheus believed he would be released – Chiron became the manifestation of this belief. Chiron believed he could not heal his wound – his dearest wish was to be released from the pain and thus Prometheus became the manifestation for this release to happen.

The lesson here is to question your own belief systems, if you are not getting your heart’s desires. Look at what your beliefs are that prevent you from “knowing” that wealth, health and happiness can be yours beyond measure. Work on these belief systems and replace them with ones that are in harmony with the Law of Attraction and your dreams will manifest themselves faster than you can imagine.

If you are not sure how to do this, get yourself a life coach to help you analyse your beliefs. Investing in a counsellor or life coach will be the smartest investment you will ever make! They will release you from your own limitations so that the low ceiling does not get in the way when you try to touch the sky.
